



Writing Funding Applications in Science and Medicine

Writing grant applications is an activity that has its own rules. On the one hand, applications have to comply with the strict requirements of the funding bodies (structure of the application, required information and conditions of funding, etc.). On the other hand, you have to 'sell' your project.

Learn how to write an application that is formally correct, presents its content accurately, and also makes a persuasive case for funding your project.

The workshop focuses on applications to the FWF (Austrian Science Fund) in the areas of basic research and clinical research.

Contents

- What are the eligibility criteria for submitting an application?
- Forms, documents, required materials
- Argumentation: Is your project relevant and realistic and does it have a good chance of success?
- Project description: Logical, complete and short!
- Planning of time and milestones

Participants: Scientists and physicians who want to submit a grant application to the FWF. Since many general aspects of grant writing will be covered in the workshop, it is also suitable for people applying for any other type of funding.
